COURSE NUMBERING

200-level Courses that do not meet degree requirements but are designated as electives only.

300-level Courses without prerequisites

SECTION DESIGNATION

The first digit will designate between multiple sections of a course (A, B, C, etc.). The second digit will designate the originating campus location for the course (K, O, M). The third digit will designate if video technology is used in the course (V). You can use the following chart to read the section designations.

First digit

K = Kansas City
O = Oklahoma City
M = Multiple locations

Technology

V = Video course
E= Online course
HV= Hybrid Course with video link for on campus meetings

CODE DESIGNATION
