**St. Paul School of Theology status changed**  
**from “Accredited – Probation” to “Accredited”**  
**Effective: February 28, 2019**

The Higher Learning Commission has removed the sanction of Probation for St. Paul School of Theology in Leawood, Kansas.

HLC took this action based on the institution’s ability to demonstrate it now meets HLC's Criteria for Accreditation. It was placed on Probation in February 2017 when it was determined to be out of compliance with HLC’s Criteria for Accreditation.
