Using Ministry Matters




The first thing to notice about Ministry Matters is that there are two reference collections. The Legacy Library and the Research Library look and behave very differently.









In the Legacy Library, the text of books has been converted to web pages that are organized in folders.

The Legacy Library includes the Bicentennial Edition of the Works of Wesley, though the most recent volumes have not yet been digitized.




Reading a text in the Legacy Library is like reading a web page. Note that if there are footnotes, they work like hyperlinks.




The Research Library collection includes newer works in the same categories as are included in the Legacy Library.




The look and feel of books in the Research Library are very different.


