**Description:** The Youth Ministry Assistant Director will collaborate with the Assistant Minister for Youth & Young Adults to guide the ministry to youth in grades 6-12 and their families at Country Club Christian Church. The Assistant Director will assist with planning and leading regular youth activities as well as special programs, events, and pastoral care needs with youth at CCCC.

**Experience:** Previous work with middle school youth in a church or camp setting preferred. Current seminary student or someone who seeks a career in full-time vocational ministry preferred.

**Affiliation:** Preference will be given to candidates from the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) but applicants from other denominational backgrounds are welcome.

**Responsibilities:** The Youth Ministry Assistant Director will be a relational and pastoral presence in the life of the youth ministry including the following expectations:

- Collaborate with the Minister to Youth about the overall mission and vision for CCCC Youth.

  each youth and reach out to guests and CCCC youth who are not actively involved.
- Support and shape a culture with CCCC Youth that is invitational and inclusive of all people, regardless of zip code, financial status, race, sexual orientation or gender expression.
- Share and support the spiritual journeys of CCCC youth and their families and seek to be informed about special joys, concerns, or challenges being faced by the youth and their family
- Participate regularly in community and school events involving youth from CCCC.
- Occasional roles in Sunday morning worship and other church-wide activities as assigned.
