- Provide weekly worship at Wesley and Bible study for students at Wesley and FUMC youth
- Lead FUMC Sr High Sunday school
- Lead FUMC Middle school and High school Youth group
- Maintain an ongoing calendar and communication of the Ehlers Wesley Student Center
- Work with church staff to schedule and publish a calendar of youth activities at FUMC
- Initiate and lead outreach/mission work emanating from Northwest Wesley and FUMC Maryville
- Coordinate and lead the annual FUMC Sr High mission trip in June
- Develop and oversee internship opportunities of ministry for student leaders

### ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with the Wesley Board to initiate and lead fundraising activities to assure the financial stability of the Wesley Foundation

### PASTORAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide a healthy and safe place for students to share concerns of faith and life
- Provide pastoral counseling at the Wesley student center when requested
- Provide compassionate care to youth in teenage life situations
- Successfully complete the MO Conference Safe Sanctuaries certification process
