Solon United Methodist Church is in the community of Solon, Iowa, located in Johnson County in eastern Iowa. The 2020 census calculations denote the population of Solon as 2,690. This reflects an increase in population from the 2010 census. Solon is expected to continue to grow as more people are drawn to the convenient location with minimal commute. Solon is in close proximity to four larger communities—Iowa City, Coralville, North Liberty, and Cedar Rapids. The town provides a good location for residents to live in a smaller community and easily commute to work in the nearby larger communities. The University of Iowa is located in Iowa City, offering employment and education opportunities. Solon's economy is composed of a few service industries, but still functions primarily as a bedroom community for the larger cities of Cedar Rapids, North Liberty, Coralville and Iowa City. Over the last two decades, construction has increased on the east, west, and south peripheries of the community. Solon allows for close proximity to Lake Macbride State Park and the Coralville Reservoir.

The Solon United Methodist Church statistical numbers for 2021 reflect a membership of 363, an average worship attendance (in person) of 70, an average on-line worship of 17, and an average of 102 participants in Christian formation groups. Solon United Methodist Church has committed leaders concerned about the church and community and willing to explore new directions and needs. There is a strong support of local groups and events...site for the Solon Food Pantry, church garden, COVID and flu clinics, scouting. The Family Life Center hosts church and community events and fund raisers. It (the Family Life Center) also brings in people from the Solon community and surrounding area. There is strong foundation for both music and Christian education. Their Vision: God is leading our congregation to be a beacon for all persons who are looking and longing for a place of spiritual refuge, inspiration, discipleship, and transformation. We will welcome them, connect, and ignite the spirit within each and show love and support to all. The church is living more deeply into its welcoming statement, as the Rev. Peggy Garrigues, who just began in July is a married lesbian minister.

- Develop, coordinate, oversee, and promote dynamic Christian Education for children, youth, families, and adults. This may include Sunday programs for nursery, children, and adults and Midweek Youth Groups, but innovative approaches to grow community are desired.
- Choose appropriate curriculum for various programs, with support from the Christian Education Team
- Recruit, train, and support volunteers to implement Christian Education programming. Support and/or lead offerings, as needed.
- Collaborate with volunteers to plan and implement off-season activities, such as Vacation Bible School, reading program, mission trips, and other seasonal and special events that attract community and promote faith development.
- Provide content for communications, to be included in places such as weekly announcements, newsletter, and social media.
